She was an accomplished athlete, with a work ethic that was impeccable. She played softball in high school, at the University of Southern Mississippi and the University of South Alabama.

Upon graduating from the University of South Alabama, Meghan continued to pursue her passion for the sport by teaching (PE and English) and coaching softball.

She began her career at UMS-Wright Preparatory School, then Thomasville High School, and finally at Jackson High School.

Meghan was known in the community for her love of family, her smile, generosity, friendship, hard work, fun loving nature, and dedication to her loved ones.

She put others before herself. In establishing this scholarship, Meghan's family wishes to recognize the dedication to continued education and the sport of softball to a graduating high school softball player.

Eligibility

Applicants to the Meghan Harbuck Overstreet Memorial Scholarship must:

Be graduating from a high school in Clarke County or be a graduate of Baker High School in current year of application.

Be planning to attend a post-secondary institution next year.

Currently hold an academic standing of a 70% average. Mid-Term transcripts are to be submitted with application.

Be an active member of their High School's Softball team.

Award Amount: \$1,500 to one graduate in Clarke County; \$1500 to one graduate of Baker High School



MEGHAN HARBUCK OVERSTREET MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

One (non-renewable) \$1,500 scholarship will be given to a senior girl attending high school in Clarke County and the same will be given to a girl attending Baker High School. The scholarship is available to any senior member of their 2024 high school softball team. Student must graduate from high school and intend on entering college in the Fall of 2024.

Program Guidelines & Priorities:

- * Seeking graduating senior softball player with a record of high achievement in the classroom and volunteerism in the community in non-school sponsored activities and participation in extracurricular school activities.
- * Applicants must be in good standing at their current high school.
- * Scholarship funds will be paid directly to the college when tuition is due at the beginning of the Fall semester. Funds are available for one year unless special permission is given to extend.
- * Application deadline is April 15, 2024.
