Scholarship Program Details

2023-2024

Packaging Corporation of America (PCA) is excited to offer three scholarships to local students interested in pursuing a degree in the engineering field. This is a full-tuition scholarship that will also cover the cost of student's required textbooks for each enrolled class.

"PCA has a strong and proud presence in the local area. We appreciate the talent of our students and are excited to invest in your education in hopes of securing talent for the future of PCA Jackson Mill!"

The successful candidate must:

1. Be a graduating senior and have already been accepted to attend a four-year college

or currently be enrolled full-time in a four-year college, with a declared major in an engineering discipline.

- Meet the ACT/SAT entrance requirements of the specific school, and any programspecific requirements of the school of engineering at the student's designated university.
- 3. Have at least a 3.0 GPA average on a 4.0 system *and* maintain this minimum GPA requirement throughout college



- coursework. Verification from school institutions will be required! Scholarships will be renewed annually based on these criteria.
- 4. Attend school in Clarke or Washington county.
- 5. Successfully complete the application and interview process for this scholarship, which includes an on-site mill tour.

Additional Scholarship Details:

- 1.The selected students agree to maintain the minimum 3.0 GPA requirement at their university. Should the student's GPA fall below the minimum level, the student will be placed on probation for one semester, allowing the student to improve upon his/her GPA. Should the student fail to regain a 3.0 GPA following the probationary semester, the student will forfeit any further scholarship monies from PCA.
- 2. The selected students understand that these scholarship funds will be awarded on an after-aid basis. This means that this scholarship will fund the remaining tuition and textbook cost after all other outside scholarship monies have been awarded to the student.

As the sponsor of your scholarship, we are investing in your future!
For these reasons, we ask that each scholarship recipient make a commitment to PCA!



- 1. This scholarship will cover the cost of tuition and textbooks for each spring and fall semester only of undergraduate studies for three selected students. Any students who accept this scholarship must agree to fully participate in PCA's co-op/internship program during the summer or applicable co-op rotational terms while enrolled at their accredited institution of choice.
- 2. The selected students will be asked to make a 5-year commitment to maintain employment with PCA upon graduation from their university, should a position become available. A contract will be provided to students upon scholarship acceptance, and both student and parent will be asked to review and sign.



All scholarships will be awarded on site at our second annual Academic Signing Day! Details will follow for chosen students.
