- **UWA is test-blind for 2025**
 - Requirements: 17 ACT or 2.5 GPA
 - Academic Scholarships starting at a 21 ACT and/or 3.0 GPA
 - Leadership Scholarships starting at a 19 ACT or 2.5 GPA
- **Free Application Week: October 7th – 11th**
 - Code: FALL2024
- **High School Leadership Day: October 15th**
 - Students will be able to interact with other student leaders, learn about what makes a great leader, and hear from professionals who are leaders within their workplace and community. Sessions will be available for sponsors who are in attendance. Students will also get the opportunity to earn leadership scholarships for their attendance
